

Jungle Meadows - Guidelines to follow

Dear Valued Guest,

To ensure a safe, respectful, and enjoyable safari experience for everyone, we kindly request all guests to strictly adhere to the following park rules and guidelines:

Entry & Permissions

Abide by all park rules at all times — no exceptions.

Obtain a valid entrance permit before entering the park.

An officially authorized guide is mandatory for all safari trips.

Strictly follow the park safari timetable.

Strictly Prohibited

Entry with arms, explosives, or crackers is strictly forbidden.

Do not carry any inflammable items during the safari.

Radios, speakers, or any musical devices are not permitted inside the park.

Smoking and littering inside the park is strictly forbidden.

Do not carry any forest property — doing so is a criminal offence.

Do not offer money or gifts to guides or staff for any rule violations.

Wildlife Etiquette

Never offer food or eatables to any bird or animal.

Do not chase, tease, or disturb any animal or bird.

Always give animals the right of way — let them cross the road first.

Maintain a safe and respectful distance from all wildlife.

On Safari

Drive strictly within the recommended speed limit of 20 km/hr.

Dismounting from the vehicle is strictly not allowed.

Eating inside the park during safari is not permitted.

Carry sufficient drinking water for the entire safari duration.

Keep your senses alert and avoid loud conversations.

We trust that your love for nature and wildlife will guide you to be a responsible and mindful guest. These rules exist to protect the forest, its inhabitants, and most importantly — you. Thank you for your cooperation
